The Brooklyn Symphony Youth Orchestra's Summer Strings program is a day camp for classical musicians. It offers young instrumentalists playing violin, viola, cello and bass two weeks of orchestra and chamber music, plus opportunities to take master classes with visiting artists.

A typical day:

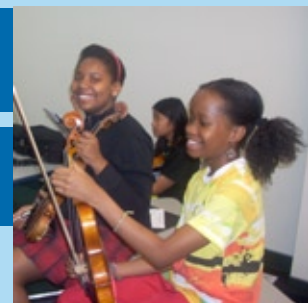
9:00 String sectional for orchestra music
10:15 Chamber music rehearsal
11:30 Chamber music coaching
12:30 Lunch
1:30 Orchestra rehearsal
3-4 Master class or semi-private lesson

The director is Kelly Howard, concertmaster of the adult Brooklyn Symphony Orchestra. Faculty are experienced teachers from New York and beyond. Master classes are given by visiting artists. Please check www.bsoyouth.org for the latest update on our line-up.

Summer Strings Camp is open to musicians age 9 to 17 who are playing repertoire around NYSSMA level 3 or 4. Shifting and vibrato are desirable. Previous orchestra or chamber playing is preferred. Students do not audition for the camp but should be ready to play 3-5 minutes of a prepared piece on the first day, for placement in a chamber ensemble and orchestra seating.

The Brooklyn Symphony Youth Orchestra Suzuki violin program is a camp for young Suzuki violinists. Students may attend for one or both weeks, and children age 3 to 5 may attend just in the mornings.

A typical day:

9:00 Semi-private lesson
10:30 Chorus
11:30 Theory (advanced) or music games (beginner)
12:30 Lunch
1:30 Fiddle
2:30-3:30 Group

The BSYO Suzuki Violin program is open to violinists age 3 to 10 who are already

learning with a Suzuki-method teacher. As with all Suzuki programs, a parent or other adult attends with the student.

The director is Kelly Howard, a well-known Suzuki teacher. Other faculty include Helene Bergman, Sarah Geller and Teresa Nelson.
